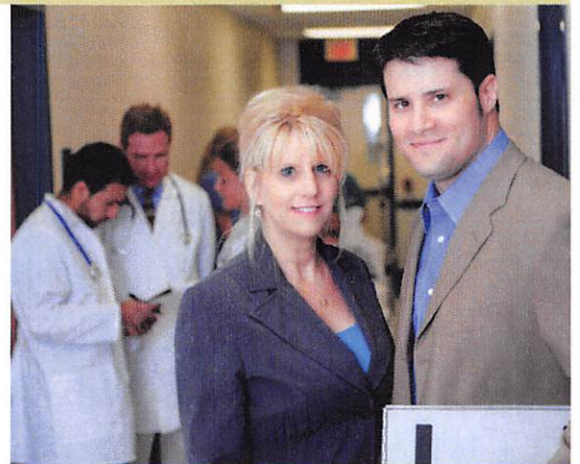
Invitation to Attend
